



Excellence in Partnership Working

Summary

This award specifically relates to organisations who are able to demonstrate they have entered into a partnership that has enhanced the level of service provided and achieved measurable savings. Partnerships can be either private or public sector or a combination of both. There will need to be evidence of why the partnership was implemented and how it has since developed. The submission should provide a clear explanation of achievements, by whom and how it compares to other organisations.

Submission

The submission should include a brief description of the service and its size. It should summarise exactly why the team believe they should be recognised with an award in Excellence in Partnership Working.

It must include a brief description of the partnership, the partnerships achievements, controls and management methods. It should also summarise exactly why the partnership believe they should win the Excellence in Partnership Working award.

It should focus on the partnerships aims and outcomes, but also provide a clear explanation of how these have been achieved, including brief details of how it operates.

There should be a clear explanation of what has been achieved, how the partnership has achieved it and what its future plans are.

The Awards panel will be looking for a clear explanation of what has been achieved and how it contributes towards the performance of the overall service. Any high-level performance indicators with comparisons to national, local and internal performance indicators, should be provided.

Note

Additional evidence is not required during the submission process. Supporting information may be requested by an Inspection Team, at a later date.
